A Great White Throne

In one of John's visions recorded for us in the book of Revelation he sees a symbolic representation of God sitting upon a great white throne to judge the earth (Revelation 20:11-15). There are some very interesting facts brought out in this passage regarding the coming day of judgment.

First, books are opened, and judgment is made according to those books. Jesus Christ said His word would judge in the last day (John 12:48). Therefore, the books John sees in this vision must be those which contain the words of Jesus. Jesus Christ is the source of the entire New Testament (Hebrews 1:1-2). When judgment comes, we will be judged by God's New Testament.

Another of the books mentioned in this context is the book of life. This book represents the fact that God knows who is saved. People who were once in this book can be blotted out (Revelation 22:19). Those whose names are not found in the book of life will be cast into the lake of fire on the day of judgment (Revelation 20:15). The lake of fire being a representation of eternal punishment (Matthew 25:41, 46; Mark 9:43-48).

One of the other interesting and important facts shown in John's vision of the judgment is the reality of a judgment according to works (Revelation 20:13). We fully understand that salvation is by the grace of God, yet accepting that reality in no way conflicts with the Biblical teaching regarding the importance of good works (Ephesians 2:10). In fact, good works, though not earning us our salvation, are necessary to salvation (Acts 2:37; James 2:14-26; Hebrews 5:8-9; Matthew 7:21-22). What one does, and more specifically whether or not he obeys God will in fact affect the outcome for them on the day of judgment.

The text also brings out the fact that all the dead shall be judged. Hades will empty its contents, after which death and Hades will be destroyed. It doesn't matter how one's body is killed, or buried, or disposed of. All will be raised and all will stand before the Lord on the day of judgment. All bodies go to the dust. All bodies dissolve back into the earth in time. This will be no means stop God from resurrecting such individuals, and having them stand before Him on the day of judgment.

This powerful picture of the dead being judged according to their works tells us that the small and great will stand before the Lord. Those whom the world considers unimportant will be judged. Those who live humble, quiet lives, and who never knew fame, earthly glory, or power will be judged. But so too will those who are great. That is those who are famous historically. Those who held great earthly power. Those who had tremendous earthly wealth. These individuals will be judged right along-side the small.

This symbolic vision of the day of judgment begins with a discussion of God sitting on the great white throne preparing for judgment. The first thing to happen is the earth and heaven fled away. This points to the same picture given to us by Peter of the last day (2 Peter 3). On the day of judgment God will take His throne. He will send His Son to take vengeance on the earth and the dead will be raised. The heavens and the earth will be destroyed, passing away with great noise, and melting with fervent heat. This material universe was created by God and will be destroyed by God. This universe cannot stand before the face of the Almighty God who comes in judgment.

The book of Revelation shows us that God comes in judgment upon nations that persecute Christians, and that He will also come in final judgment upon all of the earth. We do not know when this will happen (Matthew 24:36; 2 Peter 3:10). But we do know that it will happen (1 Thessalonians 5:1-8). Be ready.
