THE BIBLICAL VIEW OF MARRIAGE (part two)

May 23rd, 2012. I was summoned to Jury service in Winston-Salem. As the Deputy Clerk of Court was informing us of the requirements for Jury service, e.g., that one must be a citizen of the U.S. and also of North Carolina, a woman asked a question stating that since North Carolina had recently passed Amendment One to its constitution she felt that she was "no longer a citizen of North Carolina." The clerk told her she had to talk to the judge about that.

The fourteenth amendment to the U.S. Constitution provides "equal protection under the law." This amendment does not apply since same-sex marriages, civil unions, or domestic partnerships have never been a <u>right</u> bestowed to Mankind. Man does not have the right to extend "protection" to sinful acts.

One of the reasons that same-sex marriages, civil unions, or domestic partnerships have been unlawful is that they have been unlawful since the beginning of time. God's plan for the family has been modeled after the first family: Adam and Eve. It was clear that God opposes same sex relationships. Leviticus 20:13 says, "If a man also lie with mankind, as he lieth with a woman, both of them have committed an abomination: they shall surely be put to death; their blood shall be upon them." This concept is also found in the New Testament. The inspired Apostle Paul said in his letter to the Romans "Wherefore God also gave them up to uncleanness through the lusts of their own hearts, to dishonour their own bodies between themselves: Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed for ever. Amen. For this cause God gave them up unto vile affections: for even their women did change the natural use into that which is against nature: And likewise also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust one toward another; men with men working that which is unseemly, and receiving in themselves that recompence of their error which was meet." (Romans 1:24-27)

The Bible reasons with us that we should not oppose God but follow and serve Him. Same-sex marriages, civil unions, or domestic partnerships are not the rights of man but are an abomination that is against God.
