“Do Upset the Applecourt”

A man named Frank A. Clark was once quoted as saying, “Why not upset the applecourt? If you don’t; the apples will rot anyway.”

Most of us don’t like to have our “applecourt” to be upset because we get very comfortable with the status quo. Jesus faced a group in His day that fit that description very well. On two occasions Jesus overturned the tables of the moneychangers in the temple, John 2:13-18; Matthew 21:12-13. He literally upset their applecourt of man-made tradition. He also told them they had made the Word of God void by their teaching things that were contrary to the Law of Moses.

In another manner the disciples of Christ upset the applecourt. They “turned the world upside down” with the preaching of the Gospel, (Acts 17:6). That Gospel is found in the New Testament. Maybe your applecourt has been upset by the good news of Jesus Christ. Maybe your applecourt needs to be upset by that soul-saving message.

God’s message of the Gospel of Jesus Christ is the only thing that can rid your life of the sinful rotten “fruit” and enable you to bear the good fruit, the fruit of the Spirit (Galatians 5:22-23), in your life. If you are not a New Testament Christian, you need to upset your applecourt.

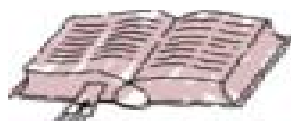
