IT'S TIME FOR OUR GOSPEL MEETING!

[The following is a summarization of an outline done by Leslie G. Thomas.]

“The time for our meeting to begin is almost here, and every member should be vitally interested in the subject now before us. The meeting is already well advertised, and it now remains for us, with the help of the Lord, to make it a success. To this end, at least three things are necessary, and to them we shall now give our attention.

THE CHURCH MUST REALIZE ITS RESPONSIBILITY. This is too often overlooked while placing the emphasis on the preacher. The work of the preacher is indispensable, but the influence of his efforts will be greatly diminished if the church does not realize its own responsibility. What, then, is the responsibility of the church as it respects a meeting? This question can best be answered, perhaps, by considering some general statements regarding the church's duty. (See, for example, 1 Tm. 3:15b; Ep 3:10; Mk 16: 15; Mt. 28:19a.)

THE CHURCH MUST BE PREPARED SPIRITUALLY:

By cleansing itself from worldliness. (1 John 2:15-17; James 1:27; 4:4.) What is worldliness? Anything that takes the mind away from God and the church, whether pleasure, business, or anything else. (Mt. 6:33.)

By praying for the meeting. It is impossible for one to pray earnestly for his fellow man and then take no interest in.

By desiring a meeting. It is certain that the church is not prepared for a meeting, if it does not desire to see sinners saved and the saints edified. ***No one can desire a thing and at the same time be indifferent toward it.***

CHURCH MUST BE WILLING TO WORK. No amount of planning and preparation will suffice, unless it is translated into action. (John 9:4; Tit. 3: 1; 1 Cor.15: 58.) Think of the great preparation that God made for the salvation of the world, and then of the effort he put forth and is still putting forth to accomplish that end. No church can be Christ-like and at the same time fail in its God-given mission”

May we all work this week to invite our friends and neighbors to hear Eddy Craft.
