GIVING OF GIFTS

Having just passed through the season of the "giving of gifts," we should contemplate briefly the concept of giving as worship. First Corinthians 16:1-2 says, "Now concerning the collection for the saints, as I gave order to the churches of Galatia, so also do ye." Wayne Jackson states concerning this passage,

"First, there is the term *diatasso*, rendered "order." The word is employed some sixteen times in the New Testament. It presupposes a subordinate relationship of one who is commanded to do something (cf. Acts 18:2; cf. Luke 17:7-10). Second, the verb "do" reflects, in the original text, a command which rather summarizes the obligation of both the Galatian churches and the Corinthian congregation. The assertion, proposed by some, that the charge here imposed was but a temporal and local requirement is incorrect. While the immediate context pertained to a specific need (relief for the churches in Judaea), the text provides a precedent for determining how any and all churches are authorized to meet their financial needs." (Christian Courier)

The first of the year is a good time to reflect on the past year's opportunities to give and to purpose one's giving for the upcoming year. Both the husband's and wife's income should be considered when deciding the amount to give. For some reason, young Christians do not feel the sense of giving as something that is expected of them. The command to give is not just expected of adults but is expected of all. Since giving is worship then in order to worship God acceptably we should give as we have been prospered. Remember, God loves a cheerful giver!

Pakistan Flood Relief

Recently we have had a request for financial help to assist Church of Christ members in Pakistan who have lost everything in the recent flood there that affected one third of the country of Pakistan. Pakistan has about 178 million people and about five million of these are classified by the government as members of denominations. Of the five million so called Christians, there are about 7000 members of the Church of Christ. The request for help is to buy blankets and food for approx. 300 Church of Christ families who have lost everything in the recent flood. This predominantly Muslims country will help other Muslims, but will not help Christians in need.

The elders have agreed to send \$1,500.00 to help with this relief effort. We can do this because your giving so far this year has been in excess of the weekly budget. This money will be wired to Pakistan and items needed will be purchased there and distributed by the **Sahiwal Central Church of Christ** in Sahiwal, Punjab Pakistan. All of you who give each Lord's day are a part of this effort.
