TOP EIGHT REASONS TO WANT TO GO TO HEAVEN

Three weeks ago, we published our top ten reasons why you are important. Two weeks ago, we wrote about the top nine reasons to love people. So, it's time for eight reasons. Today, it is the top eight reasons to want to go to heaven.

1. Heaven has no suffering.

"And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes, there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying. There shall be no more pain, for the former things have passed away" (Revelation 21:4). "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to an inheritance incorruptible and undefiled and that does not fade away, reserved in heaven for you" (1 Peter 1:3-4).

2. Heaven is God's home.

"Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven" (Matthew 5:16). "In this manner, therefore, pray: Our Father in heaven, Hallowed by your name" (Matthew 6:9). "If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask Him" (Matthew 7:11)! "And whenever you stand praying, if you have anything against anyone, forgive him that your Father in heaven may also forgive you your trespasses. But if you do not forgive, neither will your Father in heaven forgive your trespasses" (Mark 11:25-26).

3. Heaven is the home of Jesus.

“There is also an antitype which now saves us—baptism (not the removal of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God), through the resurrection of Jesus Christ, who has gone into heaven and is at the right hand of God, angels and authorities and powers having been made subject to Him” (1 Peter 3:21-22).

4. Heaven is the home of angels.

“Take heed that you do not despise one of these little ones, for I say to you that in heaven their angels always see the face of My Father who is in heaven” (Matthew 18:10). “But of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, but My Father only” (Matthew 24:36).

5. Heaven is the final home of all the saved of all nations and ages.

“For you had compassion on me in my chains, and joyfully accepted the plundering of your goods, knowing that you have a better and an enduring possession for yourselves in heaven” (Hebrews 10:34). “Rejoice and be exceedingly glad, for great is your reward in heaven” (Matthew 5:12). “We give thanks to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying always for you, since we heard of your faith in Christ Jesus and your love for all the saints; because of the hope which is laid up for you in heaven” (Colossians 1:3-5).

6. Heaven is more beautiful than we can imagine.

“In 2 Corinthians 12:1-5, Paul describes heaven as a “paradise.” This is an ancient Persian word that refers to the beautiful gardens of the Persian kings. Through the use of the “paradise,” Paul is telling us that heaven is a beautiful place.

7. Heaven is eternal.

“For we know that if our earthly house, this tent, is destroyed, we have a building from God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens” (2 Corinthians 5:1).

8. Heaven is the “country” of which all Christians are citizens.

“For our citizenship is in heaven, from which we also eagerly wait for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ” (Philippians 3:20).

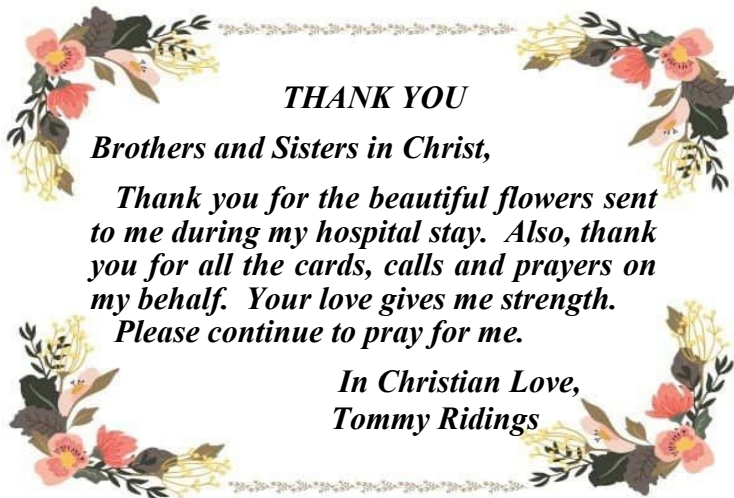
Gale Queen was scheduled to have surgery on her shoulder this past Friday. Please continue to keep her in your prayers.
