BUILDING FAITH

The length of the book of Jude is an inaccurate representation of the truths contained therein. Within the inspired text of Jude, there are many things that could be considered as faith builders." I do not know the condition of your soul this day, but I know that I can always use a piece of encouragement from the almighty God, and I hope the same can be said of you. Let me direct your mind to Jude 20-22, where the Bible reads: "But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost, Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus unto eternal life. And of some have compassion, making a difference."

When it comes to the process of making a dream become reality, we often hear the statement "let's build some dreams." The same goes for the reality of the spiritual walk. There is a building process involved, and it is extremely vital to the success and length of the journey. In the verses preceding verse 20, we are exposed to the idea of being set apart from those who are following after ungodly lusts. Enoch proclaimed for years that the Lord would return and repay vengeance to them who have rebelled against God. Then we come to verse 20. Jude says, "building up yourselves on your most holy faith." By saying this, and referencing the verses preceding, he implies that those who intend to be godly and separate from the world must have some sort of building process. The question is, on what do we build? Inspiration answers that question in the first letter to the Corinthians, through the inspired pen of Paul. Paul basically says that every man should think about how he is going to build. Realize that God has laid a foundation, and you are expected to build thereon. But, take heed how you build. You have to realize that Christ is the only foundation and if you miss that, your house is destined to fall (1 Cor. 3:9-11).

Then notice the next course of action, Jude says, "keep yourselves in the love of God." This requires continual action on the part of you and I. When we accept the "job" to build, we have to do our very best to maintain. When you build your nice, pricey house, you will do your utmost best to keep that piece of property in good shape. The same should be for the building process of the spiritual life; that is, doing our best to maintain that relationship with God that is pleasing unto Him. Paul deals with keeping ourselves in God's love in a sense (Romans 8:38-39). He claims he was persuaded that there was not a single thing in this world that could separate him from the love of God. He had his mind set on keeping himself in the love of God. If ever you stray from the fold of God, ask yourself who moved. It sure isn't God. The only person who can cause separation of you, and the only person who can keep that, is you. Next, observe "looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life." As was mentioned earlier, the building and keeping process is that of a continual action. There is no time to rest, or to quit working. We sing the hymn, "We'll Work Till Jesus Comes," but the question is . . . Will you really?

In the gospel of John 9:4, Jesus says that while it is day He is going to be doing the Father's business because soon there will be a time when that work is o'er. He is influencing us to do the same. Work the work of the Father while you're here, looking unto the day when Jesus takes you home if you've been faithful. The last statement made in Jude, at which we will look, is making a difference." Once you have accepted the task to build your life upon the foundation of Jesus, you have committed yourself to a life of maintaining a pure life in the eyes of God, and looking to your home in heaven. Now, of course you would want yourself to be faithful because that is the only way into heaven. But, Jesus was concerned about making a difference in the world, and so should you and I. Jesus said, "As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world." He put his conviction to practice. He made a difference. Remember, there is nothing as useless as a virtue untested. Build on the Lord Jesus, keep a healthy relationship, look unto eternity with eyes of faith, and make a difference. It is up to you!
