Prioritize, Simplify, Believe, and Pray”

The peace that Christ offers involves peace with God and peace with one's fellowman. Jesus also offers peace with oneself, sometimes called, “peace of mind.” Often that can be defined as the absence of mental stress, or anxiety. Some would also include sanity, calm, and quiet comfort of mind.

We're familiar with anxiety; it's a common problem. Being a Christian doesn't exempt one from it. The faithful can be troubled by anxiety. Recall how Jesus' friend Martha had to deal with it (Luke 10:38-41)? Anxiety can affect work, life at home, and friendships. It can also affect the work of the church. It has been said, “The beginning of anxiety is the end of faith and the beginning of faith is the end of anxiety.”

*God's solution for dealing with anxiety includes the following: **prioritizing**, Matthew 6:31-34; **simplifying**, Luke 10:41-42; **believing**, Matthew 6:25; John 14:1; and **praying**, Philippians 4:6-7. Christian living involves being a peacemaker (Matthew 5:9). To be a peacemaker one must be at peace with oneself. That involves having been reconciled to God through Christ, living in peace with mankind and being at peace with oneself.*
