WHO IS JESUS?

(John 1)

There are at least ten different ways in which Jesus Christ referred to in the first chapter of John's Gospel account. Each of these is as much a description as it is a designation. Let's see what we can learn about Jesus through these ten ways of referring to Him.

1. Jesus is called the Word (John 1:1-3).

This conveys the fact that Jesus Christ is the source of the divine word. That is, He is the source and the embodiment of truth.

2. Jesus is called God (John 1:1).

The fact that Jesus Christ was there at the beginning, and that He is in fact the creator of all things proves that He is divine.

3. Jesus is also here referred to as the Creator (John 1:3).

Because He is the Word, because He is God, and because He is the Creator, He naturally has authority over every person.

4. Jesus is the Light (John 1:4-9).

Ignorance, error, and evil are darkness. The world is filled with darkness. Jesus is the Light that can show the world the way to peace and eternal life.

5. Jesus is the Only Begotten of the Father (John 1:14, 18).

This is the Father's only Divine Son. He is special and unique. If you and I are Christians then we are children of God, but are not His children in the same special and divine way in which Christ is the Only Begotten of the Father.

6. The Lamb of God (John 1:29, 36).

This idea takes us back to the Passover of Exodus twelve when the lambs were sacrificed and the blood put on the door-post to save the first born. This all pointed to Jesus as the Lamb of God who would give His blood to make possible the forgiveness of sins.

7. The Son of God (John 1:34, 49).

This does not imply any kind of physical origin for Jesus, but rather this helps us in understanding His relationship with God the Father. The Father has authority over the Son.

8. The Messiah/Christ (John 1:41).

The Hebrew word "messiah" is equivalent to the Greek word "christ." This word refers to one who is anointed to a specific task. Jesus is the Messiah, the Christ. He is the One appointed by God to the task offering salvation to mankind through His sacrifice.

9. The King of Israel (John 1:49).

Jesus is the king of all the world. He is the king of His church, and He is the king of Israel. He was descended from the line of kings through King David. Now He rules by the right hand of the throne of God, and He will exercise His authority someday to judge the world.

10. The Son of Man (John 1:51).

This indicates the human side of Jesus as He lived here upon this earth. He was still the Son of God, even as He was the Son of Man. It is because Jesus became a son of man that He is able to understand the complexities and temptations of life.
