What Can I Do To Alter The Wickedness In The World?

The world can seem excessively wicked and sometimes more than others. Does it bother us? Does it make us cringe? Do we wish it would change? What do we do? Let’s talk about what we can do to make the world a better place.

First, we need to make sure that the wickedness of the world hasn’t got us. If we are ever going to make a difference in this world, we must be different from the world. We cannot allow the things that we are wanting to change to influence us so that we are part of the problem. Think about **2 Corinthians 6:14**, *“Do not be unequally yoked together with unbelievers. For what fellowship has righteousness with lawlessness? And what communion has light with darkness?”*

Secondly, we need to pray to God. Why is this so important? God is the one who has supreme authority over this world. Under His control, He can make things happen that otherwise wouldn’t. He can intervene and make the changes that we are asking for. He is the Force that can implement our prayers into the world we live in. Think about **Philippians 4:6**, *“Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God;”*.

Lastly, we need to perform our calling. This is where a lot of people fail. They want to pray and pray, but they never want to do their part. We must be the light to the world so that the darkness can be altered. We have been called to be the light to the world around us. Think about **Matthew 5:16**, *“Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.”* When we choose to let our light shine, we cause a ripple effect that will then go out into the entire world. Never take what we can do individually for naught. You can change the world for the better!

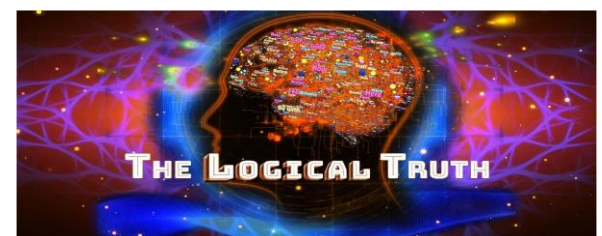
