PANAMA UP CLOSE

On Saturday, January 15, Allen Womack and I met Bill Clements, another elder from the Eastridge Church of Christ, in Panama City, Panama. We were supposed to fly in a small, two engine plane to Bocas del Toro early Sunday morning, January 16, in order to worship with several of the congregations in the Bocas area. However, we did not receive the notice of a flight schedule change that was made after we left the States. Even though we arrived at the airport two hours early based upon the original schedule, the plane had already left for Bocas. So we called a taxi, found a hotel relatively close to the airport, and spent another night in Panama City.

On Monday, January 17, we flew to Bocas del Toro, where Alfonso Smith met us at the airport. After we checked into a hotel, we took a boat ride to the Island of Solarte, where Alfonso preaches, and met with the congregation at the church building. Alfonso also preaches at the congregation in Bocas. The congregation sang a few songs and I led a prayer translated by Alfonso. Allen then made a few comments to the members. After that the children gave a short skit about Solomon judging which mother the baby belonged to. Before we left, Allen made a group picture of the congregation and we took the boat to several other islands to meet with the congregations. Each place we went only a few people were there. They explained that the whole congregation had been waiting for us on Sunday and had prepared a meal for us, but we didn't come. Each time we had to explain about the flight delay from Panama City to Bocas. We returned to the hotel in Bocas before dark.

On Tuesday, January 18, we took a 1½ hour boat ride to a town named Kusapin, which is located on a peninsula off the mainland of Panama. While traveling to Kusapin, the small fiberglass boat [with an outboard motor] we were traveling in was exposed to the ocean waters. Although I was concerned about the rolling waves, I did not get sick. I even avoided becoming queasy by looking at the sky a lot instead of the waves. I'm the type that usually gets queasy on fair rides that spin you around. We looked at the site for the church building campaign in March of 2011. On the way back to Bocas we stopped at several islands where congregations are located.

On Wednesday morning, January 19, we confirmed our flight to Panama City and then visited the island of Bastimentos to see a lot that was available for purchase as a building site for the church there. We returned to Bocas later that morning and caught the afternoon flight to Panama City. It was important for us to make the afternoon flight on Wednesday because we were scheduled to catch the Delta flight to Atlanta early the next morning.

On Thursday, January 20, Allen, Bill, and I took the hotel's courtesy van to the airport at 6:00 AM and caught the 8:00 AM flight to Atlanta, GA. I then flew from Atlanta to Greensboro, NC, where I was glad to see Jeannie about 4:00 PM. It was a good trip, but long and tiring, and I'm glad to be home in the good old USA.
