## Grace Through Faith

The charge against us is sin (Romans 3:23). The charge carries a penalty of death (Romans 1:32). We are cleared from the charges (justified) by the grace of God through his redemption (ransom paid) that is in Christ Jesus (Romans 3:24).

The charge against us is sin (Romans 3:23). The charge carries a penalty of wrath (Romans 1:19). We can avoid the penalty because an appeasement of wrath has been accomplished (Romans 1:25). God set forth Christ Jesus as the propitiation (the sacrifice that appeased the wrath for sin) by His blood, through faith (Romans 3:25).

“Therefore, having been justified (charges cleared) by faith, we have peace (not the wrath we deserve) with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God (Romans 5:1-2). Because we have been justified by His blood shall be saved from wrath through Him (Romans 5:9).

None of this is deserved (Romans 3:24). None of this is earned (Romans 5:15). God owes us nothing (Romans 4:1-4). We owe Him everything (Romans 6:23). We earned death by our sin (Romans 6:23). God provides life through the death of Jesus Christ (Romans 6:23). “For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lets anyone should boast (Ephesians 2:8-9).”

Facts: We are saved by grace through faith. We cannot earn or deserve salvation. Question: What does this mean with regard to individual responsibility and accountability? How do grace and faith connect with humble submission to God? Man has been given free-will by God (Genesis 2:15-17; Joshua 24:15; Ezekiel 18; Revelation 22:17). If there is no free-will there can be no individual accountability. There is individual accountability (Romans 14:10). Therefore, there is free-will (Acts 10:34-35). In connection with this we must consider the fact that while grace is available to all men (Titus 2:11), and the propitiation makes forgiveness possible for all men (1 John 2:2), grace for salvation will only be given to those who choose of their own free-will to humble themselves under the mighty hand of God (1 Peter 5:5-6).

When people refuse to submit to the will of God they are choosing to be lost (Acts 13:46). When people choose to humbly submit to the will of God, He will save them (Matthew 7:21-22; Hebrews 5:8-9). Though people must have a faith that is accompanied by works of obedience to God in order to be saved (James 2:14-26), they must know that when they are saved they are receiving something which they do not deserve, and did not earn. That is, they are saved by grace apart from humble submission to the will of God (1 Peter 5:5-6). But, when one humbly submits to the will of God he is saved by the grace of God.

Therefore, one cannot be saved by grace if he chooses to set his own standard of righteousness (Romans 10:1-4). Further, one cannot be saved by grace if he refuses to obey God (2 Thessalonians 1:3-12).


