ELDERS CORNER:

The Quran and Jesus Christ

Islam, which had its beginning in A.D. 610 when Muhammad (A.D. 570-632) claimed he began receiving revelations from the angel Gabriel, is a mystery to most Americans. And one of the great unknowns to most people, our brethren included, is the fact that Islam greatly distorts and outright denies much of the Biblical testimony concerning Jesus. Yes, they believe Jesus existed and that he was a messenger of their God Allah—but the Jesus of the Quran is not the Jesus of the Bible. This denial is accomplished in at least three ways. First, by denying that Jesus died on the cross. Second, by rejecting the Scriptural truth that Jesus is the Son of God. And third, as one might expect, following from the above they deny the Biblical concept of the Godhead. "Here, indeed, is the number one conflict between Islam and Christianity: the deity and person of Christ." 1 You see, most of the focus of the Quran is on Muhammad rather than Jesus. One author put it like this:

"It is very problematic to give the Quran any divine status when its message is fundamentally directed toward Muhammad, not Jesus, and to Mecca, not Calvary." 2

As documentation of the distortions the Quran makes about Jesus we offer the following quotations from the Quran itself:

"As for their claim that they killed the Messiah Jesus, son of Mary, the messenger of God, the truth is they did not kill him nor did they crucify him. They were under the illusion that they had..." [Surah 4:157]. 3

"The Christians affirm that the Christ is the son of God. Such is the talk of their mouths: it is the kind of thing that unbelievers have alleged in earlier times. May they perish at god's hand: perverse are all their thoughts! They take...the Christ, son of Mary also, displacing the worship of God. This — they were commanded to worship one God only..." [Surah 9:30]. 4

"People of the Book, do not go to unwarranted lengths in your religion and get involved in false utterances relating to God...and do not talk of three gods." "Surely they are unbelievers who allege that God is the third of three! There is no god but One." [Surah 4:171 & Surah 5:73]. 5

These examples alone from the Quran are sufficient to set forth the heretical nature of Islamic belief and teaching about Jesus and the Godhead. It is clear from these Surahs that Muslims believe:

- Jesus was not crucified.
- Jesus was/is not the Son of God.
- Jesus is not God.
- There is no Godhead.

On the other hand, the New Testament affirms that Jesus is:

- Our God (Mt.1:23; Heb.1:8).
- Our Creator (Jn.1:1; Col.1:16).
- Our Savior (Lk.19:10; Acts 4:12).
- Our Head (1 Cor.11:3; Eph.5:23).
- Our Mediator (1 Tim.2:5).
- Our Lord (Jn.20:28; Phil.2:9-11).
- Our Advocate (1Jn.2:1-2).
- Our Judge (Jn.5:22; 2 Cor.5:10).
- Our only avenue to the Father (Jn.14:6).

Both of these positions about Jesus Christ cannot be right. To believe one you must deny the other. Which do you choose? I choose Jesus!
