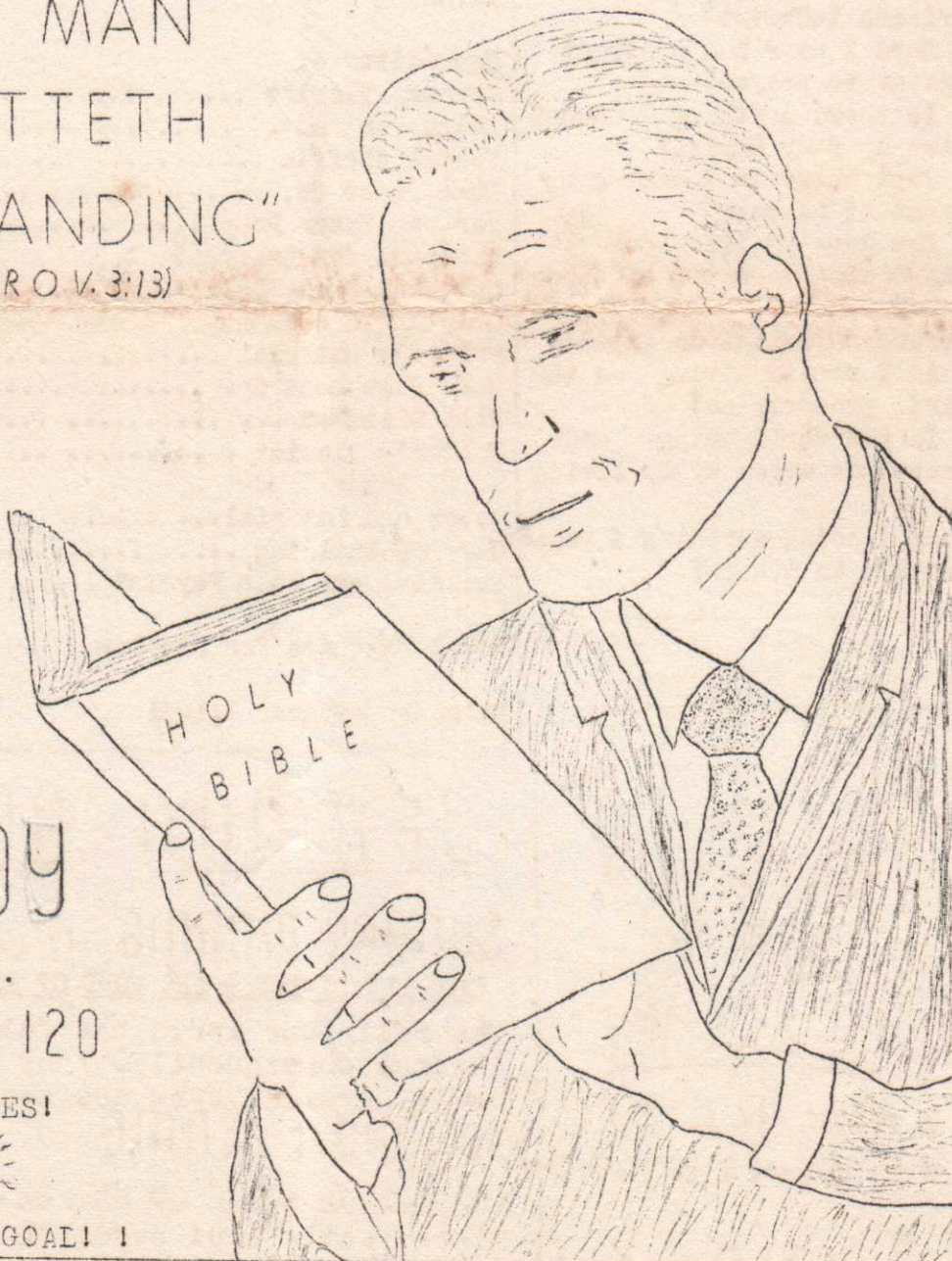

THE BIBLE TEACHES

The Bible teaches that "by grace have ye been saved through faith" (Eph.2:8). Some have supposed that this statement excludes any act of obedience as a prerequisite to our salvation. This is not so as Christ said, "When ye shall have done all the things that are commanded you, say, We are unprofitable servants; we have done that which it was our duty to do" (Luke 17:10). Thus we see that not only one command but all commandments of God may be kept and we are still unprofitable servants and our salvation is by God's grace.

Though salvation is by grace and is a gift of God, yet the obedience of the recipient of this grace is required. An example is a gift God gave to the Israelites in the long ago. When Israel compassed Jericho God said, "See, I have given into thy hand Jericho" (Josh 6:2). Nevertheless He commanded them to do certain things and these commandments were obeyed. When they had obeyed all His commandments in this matter Joshua said to the people, "Shout; for Jehovah hath given you the city" (Josh 6:16). Thus it is evident that a gift may be conditioned upon the obedience of the receiver.

So it is with our salvation. It is by the grace of God but we are not the beneficiaries of this grace till we obey God's Commandments. Salvation is the gift of God but is received when we have obeyed His will. Christ has become "the author of eternal salvation to all them that obey him" (Heb. 5:9), so being saved by the grace of God and receiving His gift does not exclude our obedience.

Let us have faith in God and in what The Bible Teaches.
