The Power of a Godly Mother

Introduction: Prov. 31:25, 28

- I. The Mother Letting God GUIDE (2 Tim. 1:5)
 - A. There is power in a mother who allows God to guide her in her life, duty, and purpose.
 - B. She respects God’s instruction for her role, her work, and her purpose.
 - C. Pride, arrogance, and challenging authority is not part of her life.
 - D. She desires her children to be guided and faithful to God and so she shows this by her example.
 - E. She realizes that her example is molding future generations of her family.
- II. The Mother Letting God PROTECT (Ex. 2:1-4)
 - A. There is power in a mother who allows God to protect their child.
 - B. She does what is her role, purpose, and duty, but gives her child to God to protect.
 - C. She trusts in the protection of God to protect, provide, and take care of her child.
 - D. Her faith, that she exemplified while under her care, continues after the child has left.
 - E. She shows that the same God who is able to protect, provide, and care for her CAN do the same for her child.
- III. The Mother Letting God DELIVER (Mk. 7:24-30)
 - A. There is power in a mother who allows God to deliver their child out of problems, mistakes, and bad choices.
 - B. She will continue doing her role, purpose, and work as a mother, but she believes God can do certain things she can’t.
