WORK PLAN GOALS FOR 2008

One of the goals for 2008 is to increase the support for the ZSOBS.

The school facilities are capable of handling 50 students (two classes of 25) with 25 graduating every year. The school only has enough financial support to take in 15 students every two years. Warners has agreed to increase our support for two years beginning in Jan. 2008, so the school can accept 25 men to train as preachers for the next two years. This means that Warners will provide funding for training 10 additional preachers. The cost to train 10 preachers is 900.00 per month for 24 This includes housing, feeding, training and a monthly months. allowance. This is a wonderful opportunity to train preachers that hopefully, will spend the rest of their lives preaching the gospel of Christ. These men can be trained for a fraction of what it costs to train a preacher in the US. Many of these graduates go on to teach in other preacher school in African countries. Another great thing about the preacher schools in Africa is there is no shortage of men who want to attend them.
