Captain John Callender of the Massachusetts Militia was found guilty of cowardice at the Battle of Bunker Hill. George Washington had to order his court martial. But Callender re-enlisted in the army as a private, and at the Battle of Long Island, exhibited such conspicuous courage that Washington publicly revoked the sentence and restored Callender's rank of Captain.

*Oftentimes in this old life we find the need to start over. Very often at the outset of starting over, it can be painful and humbling. It's the same way with the sinner you know. Yes, you do know who I'm writing to. A person can change — a person can start over; no matter the circumstances or age. The Bible says with regard to becoming a Christian, **“we were buried with Him in baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we should walk in newness of life.”** (Romans 6:4).*

*It can be painful in leaving the pattern you've been used to following. It can mean that your pride suffers in admitting that your old ways are not God's ways after all. But as Jesus was raised in newness of life, so we can be. The reality of such is that when one obeys the gospel, you will be a new creature walking in the footsteps of Jesus, walking in **the newness of life**.*

These items will be distributed to needy children by the SW PTA Food Pantry.
