**Because They Chose God**

In Daniel 3, we are told of an account involving Hannah, Mishael, and Azariah. These were the 3 friends mentioned of Daniel. In this text, they took a stand against Nebuchadnezzar that ultimately would've cost them their lives, but they still lived. In today's world, we are faced with threats that if we were to just take after the courage of these three friends, God can also deliver us. In this chapter, Nebuchadnezzar makes an image and commands everyone in the Empire to bow down to it and worship it. The three friends said no. But the reason why they said no was because they knew that it would be against God. Nebuchadnezzar even gives them a second chance to bow, but they still said no. They even went on to say in verses 17 and 18, "17 If that is the case, our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and He will deliver us from your hand, O king. 18 But if not, let it be known to you, O king, that we do not serve your gods, nor will we worship the gold image which you have set up." Even when the threats were so severe and their lives were on the line they had already made up their mind. They knew that they served a God that could deliver them and that their lives were better in His hands. My friends, we know the rest of the story. God delivered them from the fiery furnace. He helped them because they put their lives in His hands. I think this is a great lesson for us to learn today. If only we fully put our lives into the hands of God, there is nothing in this world that can destroy us. We may die physically, but spiritually we will live forever. My prayer for us all today is that we may have the courage to make up our minds to stay with God and not be willing to waiver...NO MATTER WHAT!

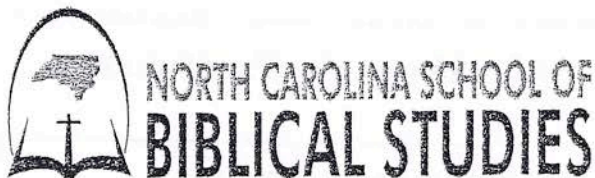

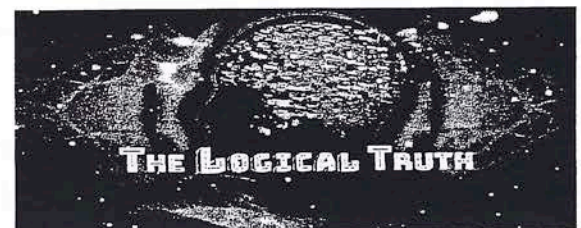
