## **ARE THE UNBAPTIZED LOST?**

Post-modernism is that philosophy which tells us there is absolutely no such thing as absolute truth. This self-contradictory position has been the major philosophy governing American morals for the past several years. Stemming from this philosophy is the politically correct notion that we should not be judgmental under any circumstances. Of course, those who take that position judge true Christianity harshly, and show themselves to be hypocrites.

It is most certainly true that we must be careful about how we judge others. Matthew 7:1-5 speaks against the sin of making hypocritical judgments while giving us the strong and foreboding warning, "For with what judgment you judge, you will be judged." Jesus Christ gave the command, "Do not judge according to appearance...(John 7:24)," and Paul condemned judging a brother in matters of conscience [liberty/opinion] (Romans 14:10). But, are we not commanded to do some judging? The end of John 7:24 says, "...judge with righteous judgment."

The non-judgmental doctrine has so affected our society that it has now permeated the church. We most definitely need to make sure we do not become sinfully judgmental (James 2:1-13). However, we need to stand up for the truth and that means making judgments. No man can be the final judge dispensing eternal just sentence upon mankind. That is for Jesus (Acts 17:30-31). Yet, there is some judgment we need to make now. That is righteous judgment, and

righteous judgement is that which is grounded firmly upon the judgments already made by Jesus. Our Lord said, “He who rejects Me, and does not receive My words-the word that I have spoken will judge him in the last day. For I have not spoken on My own authority; but the Father who sent Me gave Me a command, what I should say and what I should speak. And I know that His command is everlasting life. Therefore, whatever I speak, just as the Father has told Me, so I speak.” (John 12:48-50) In this passage Jesus tells us that His Words will judge all of those who reject Him. Look at Jesus’ words in Mark 16:16. Jesus said, “He who believes and is baptized will be saved...” These are the words of Jesus, and therefore these are words that will judge mankind. Jesus Christ has already judged that those who refuse to believe and be baptized will be condemned.

What does this tell me about people I have known who have died without being baptized into Christ? This verse tells me they are lost. Jesus told us they are lost. Jesus has already judged them to be lost. I am not making a hypocritical judgment when I repeat the words of Jesus. I am not making a judgment according to appearance when I quote the words of Christ. I am not making a judgment concerning anything that is a matter of conscience when I tell people that all those who have died, without having been baptized into Christ are lost. I am simply repeating the judgment that Jesus has already made.
