“Top Priority”

Most of us have had the experience of calling the doctor for an unscheduled appointment and being told, “Come on in and we’ll work you in.” What that means, of course, is that they’ll get to you when they can fit you in around those who already have scheduled appointments. Someone told me that once they had to sit for three hours waiting to be “worked in.” They appreciated getting to be seen on short notice, but they were aware that they were not “top priority.”

So where are you placing God in your life right now? Have you got Him sitting in the waiting room of your life; thinking He will accept being just “worked in” after you have tended to all the other things in your life (many of which you made an appointment for)?

congregations in the area and offered monthly support. We had radio programs being broadcast on WTOB and WAIR and were actively supporting gospel meetings in the area. It is interesting to note that in this bulletin we were supporting a work in France.

In 1948, Warners Chapel led an outreach effort in Boone, NC and brother Max Johnson spoke there at least monthly. Warners Chapel even purchased a tent to hold the meetings under.

Here is an interesting snippet from the November 30, 1947 bulletin concerning an unusual outreach effort this congregation was involved in.

AT 8:30 THIS MORNING
Bro. Johnson conducted the morning devotional period at the Forsyth County Tuberculosis Sanatorium. Thus another opportunity of doing good is opened to us.

Next week we'll focus on one of the largest foreign mission works that this congregation has actively been involved with for 15 years, and that work is Nicaragua.
