DEALING WITH DISCOURAGEMENT

Someone has said, “If you don’t deal with discouragement, it will deal with you.”

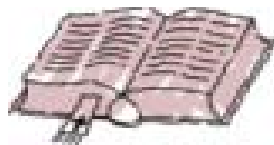
