CAROLINA OUTREACH

Three years ago the elders responded to an opportunity that was presented to them by the brethren at the Northwest church in Greensboro. A mutual plan was concocted between the two groups of Elders for workers to come to the area surrounding the Northwest church and knock doors to invite their neighbors to attend a Gospel Meeting that was conducted there by students of the North Carolina School of Biblical Studies. I was privileged to speak on Sunday morning at that meeting.

At some point after that event, the Elders at Warners Chapel were inspired to create a new mission effort that could benefit the Church in the Carolinas. Carolina Outreach was born.

The purpose of Carolina Outreach is to identify small churches in the Carolinas that Warners could help with the great resources that we have here. One thing is sure, we want to help churches, not organize or oversee them. The leaders of Carolina Outreach emphatically express that we want the hosting church to plan and implement the event. Carolina outreach is there to provide some of the "legwork" for them and we absorb the costs of sending workers to door-knock, teach classes and provide a speaker for a Gospel Meeting for them.

After responding to the request at the Northwest church, The Kinston church was selected for the next venue in 2014 and we are currently assisting the Bayside church of Christ in Elizabeth City, NC. Workers from Warners and students from the school started door-knocking Thursday and will continue through Saturday. I will begin a Gospel Meeting on Sunday and conclude on Wednesday night. Our theme is, "What Does The Bible Say..."

The church at Warners Chapel supports several Mission efforts around the world and has been diligent in exploring new opportunities to serve the Lord's church. Mission work is needed everywhere and am proud that the Elders here have chosen doing local mission work in addition to the works we support around the globe.

The churches that Carolina Outreach has served have greatly expressed their appreciation to many of us for assisting them in their efforts to serve the Lord and we thank them for the opportunities they provide us to serve our Lord as well.

WHAT KIND OF FAITH DO YOU HAVE?

The word of God makes it absolutely imperative that we have faith in God (Hb 11:6) and Jesus (Jn 8:24) in order to please God and be saved. However, it also makes it just as clear that we must do more than believe--Ja 2:14-26! Consider several types of faith referred to in the New Testament:

- 1 A saving faith--Ja 2:14-26.
- 2 A living faith--Gl 2:20.
- 3 A faith working by love--Gl 5:6 + 1 Th 1:3.
- 4 A godly faith--Rm 10:4-6 + G1 5:5.
- 5 A growing faith--2 Th 1:3 + 2 Pt 1:5-8.
- 6 An unfeigned faith--1 Tm 1:5 + 2 Tm 1:5.
- 7 A devils (demons) faith--Ja 2:19.
- 8 A dead faith--Ja 2:20 + 26.
- 9 A vain faith--1 Cr 15:2 + 4.
- 10 A shipwrecked faith--1 Tm 1:19.

Brethren, in order to have a saving faith we must make sure it comes by way of God's word (Rm 10:17), that it is obeyed (Rm 16:26), that it is lived (Gl 2:20), that we walk in it (Rm 14:12), that it causes us to serve and sacrifice for the cause of Christ (Pp 2:17), that we continue in it (Cl 1:23), that we stand fast by it (1 Cr 16:13), that we keep it (2 Tm 4:7), that we never depart from it (1 Tm 1:4), that we never deny it (1 Tm 5:8), that we never cast it off (1 Tm 5:12), that we never err from it (1 Tm 6:10), that we allow no one to overthrow it (2 Tm 2:18), and that our minds never become reprobate concerning it (2 Tm 3:8).

By faith we purify our hearts (Ac 15:9), are born again (1 Jn 5:1), are sanctified (Ac 26:18), receive the promises of Christ (Gl 3:14+22), are edified (1 Tm 1:4), draw near to God (Hb 10:22-23), resist the devil (1 Pt 5:8-9), and find the salvation of our soul (1 Pt 1:9+2 Tm 4:6-8)!

Do you believe in God and that Jesus Christ is the only begotten Son of God and Saviour of the world? (Hb 11:6, Jn 11:25-26, Ac 8:37 + Jn 3:16) Still may we ask, WHAT KIND OF FAITH DO YOU HAVE? Is your faith in God and Jesus an active, working, loving, serving, sacrificing, enduring faith with the hope of eternal life? May it ever so be. Amen.
