"THE POWER OF PRAYER"

One example of the power of prayer is that the Christian can find forgiveness from God. The Bible teaches that God is in the light. We should also live in the light. If we live in the light then we have a relationship of sharing with each other. The blood of Jesus, God's Son, continues to cleanse us from all sin. If we say, "We have no sin!" then we are only fooling ourselves. The truth is not in us. However, if we confess our sins, then God will forgive us. We can trust God; He does what is right. He will cleanse us from every evil thing. (I John 1:7-9)

We have an example of this in Acts 8. Simon the sorcerer believed the gospel and was baptized into Christ. He was now a Christian. He continued with Philip and was amazed by the signs and miracles. Then, Simon saw that the Holy Spirit was given to the people when the apostles put their hands on them. So Simon offered the apostles some money and said, "Give me this power so that when I put my hands on a person, he will receive the Holy Spirit." "But Peter said to him, 'Your money perish with you because you thought that the gift of God could be purchased with money! You have neither part nor portion in this matter, for your heart is not right in the sight of God. Repent therefore of this your wickedness and pray God if perhaps the thought of your may be forgiven you." (Acts 8:20-22)

Christians have therefore a command in 1 John 1:7-9 and an example in Acts 8. If we confess our sin to God and pray for His forgiveness, the blood of Christ will still cleanse him or her of their sin. Yes the power of the blood is the cleansing agent. Yet the Christian must confess his sin and ask for God's forgiveness. The Christian has the assurance of knowing that any sin he might commit after becoming a child of God, can be forgiven. Prayer is powerful.

Zambia Work

In case you do not have e-mail or did not read the latest Newsletter from Jerry and Edith Sullins on the work in Zambia, here is a summary.

On November 26, 2011, the ZSOBS will graduate 19 preachers who have completed the two-year course. This will make 160 preachers graduated since 1988. These men go back to their villages or new areas and preach the gospel as trained preachers, hopefully for the rest of their lives. Since they are properly trained, they are accepted into existing congregations and many times are able to correct error in that congregation. This rarely happens in this country. If they cannot correct error, they are taught to start a new congregation that respects God's word.

In addition to the 160 graduates from ZSOBS from 12 African Countries, the preachers school in Uganda was started by graduates of ZSOBS and has graduated 33 students as of Nov. 19, 2011. Graduates of ZSOBS are teaching in 7 other preacher schools in Africa.

This work is just one of the many good works Warners is involved in both in the United States and other countries. Your giving is what makes it possible to continue helping with these great works.
