"Unshakable Confidence"

Victor Vroom has devised what is called the "expectancy theory." He maintains that people are motivated when four contingencies are met. First, they must believe that the reward being offered for a particular behavior is worth the effort to get it. Second, they must be confident of their ability to perform the required task. Third, they must be convinced that accomplishing that task is possible in the present set of circumstances. Finally, they must be certain that the one who made the promise is credible and will keep the promise.

Translation? The apostle Paul wrote, "For this reason I also suffer these things; nevertheless I am not ashamed, for I know whom I have believed and am persuaded that He is able to keep what I have committed to Him until that day." 2 Tim.1:12. Paul had an unshakable confidence in Christ's promises of eternal life; so much so that He accepted the hardships of preaching the gospel.
