GOD IS OUR SHIELD

While at a softball game I happened to witness a woman who was struck in the mouth by a "donut" that had been secured to a bat. A "donut" is a round device used to add additional weight to a bat while swinging in the On-Deck circle before one's turn at batting in a game. She had been sitting near the On-Deck Circle but was not behind a protective barrier. She lost three teeth.

A friend of mine was attempting to repair the front brakes on his car and was trying to save money by doing the job himself. He had just taken off his goggles as they were fogging up from the heat. The grip he had on one of the springs slipped and the spring flew and struck him in the eye. This was his "good eye" as he had Amblyopia in the other eye when he was a child. This accident decreased his vision.

Each of these people suffered tremendously from their accidents. Yet each one had access to protection but was not taking advantage of it at the time of their accident. These tragedies could have been avoided.

God is our help and our shield. The Bible says in Psalms 33:20, "Our soul waiteth for the LORD: he is our help and our shield." God has given us rules to live by that will protect us. I am never going to get stabbed or shot and killed in a bar if I don't go in one. I will never get Lung Cancer from abusing my lungs with cigarette smoke, if I don't smoke. I am never going to be incarcerated for possession of illegal drugs if I don't acquire any. He intends for his commands to be like a protective barrier of a pair of goggles.

However, God's commands cannot enrich us or protect us if we disobey them. God will not be our help and shield if we do not follow them. If we ignore or disobey God's commands they are like a protective barrier that is not being used or a pair of goggles that are not being worn. But if we obey God's commands he will help us and shield us from life's many perils.

WHAT DO YOU WANT YOUR CHILDREN TO BECOME?

President Theodore Roosevelt had four sons. He was very proud when the first three sons announced their intention to join the military. But when his fourth son also decided to join the army, the old Rough Rider balked. "Not all my boys," he said to his wife. But she replied, "Ted, if you raise them as eagles, you can't expect them to fly like sparrows."

All parents should have a dream for their children. Isaiah put it this way. "And all thy children shall be taught of the Lord; and great shall be the peace of thy children" (Isaiah 54:13).

You announce what you want your children to be by what you teach them.

It's not the church's responsibility to teach your children. It's yours as a mother and father. Several years ago, I talked with a man who at one time had been in a non-Sunday school congregation. When I asked him why, he said, "we did not object to classes. What we were afraid of was that if we provided classes at the church, then parents would quit teaching at home." Was he right?

You announce what you want your children to be by the example you set.

It's amazing how some parents put ball games, camping trips, golf games, and fishing trips above attending worship, and then they wonder why their children leave the church. Someone wrote, "What you are thunders so loudly that I cannot hear what you say."

You announce what you want your child To be by the plans you make for them.

Your children know if something is really important to you. Have you been saying from the time they started to school, "Now make good grades so that someday you can go to college"? They know you want them to get a college education. But what about your spiritual dreams for them? Have you encouraged them to be preachers, missionaries, Bible school teachers, elders, or deacons? By your plans, you have told them what you think is important.

The greatest thing you can do for your children is to plant the seeds of faith in their hearts. College is not the most important thing in the world. Let your children know that more than anything else, you want them to be faithful Christians.
