## IS CONFESSION NECESSARY

The word CONFESSION means to admit or acknowledge our sins and faults.

In the Old Testament we find that when a man or woman committed any sin that they had to confess that sin which had been done and to recompense or repay the one that they had sinned against and to pray for forgiveness from God.

If we do not confess to know God before men then how do we expect God to know us in the judgment. Christ says, "Whomsoever therefore shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before my Father which is in heaven. But whosoever shall deny me before men, him will I also deny before my Father which is in heaven."

You cannot find in the Bible anywhere where Christ was healing the sick and afflicted that he did not first get their confession. He would ask, "Dost thou believe on the Son of God?" If they confessed and believed in him, Jesus would heal them in his fathers name. If we didn't confess our sins and mistakes, we wouldn't be showing our need of being cleansed and baptized into Christ and his church.

The Apostle Paul says, "If thou confess with thou mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved." For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. For whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed but that calleth upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.
