THE CHURCH OF THE BIBLE

I. There is only one church

- A. Jesus built the church (Matthew 16:16-19)
 - 1. Jesus built the church and it belongs to Him
 - 2. Jesus promised to build one church, not many
- B. Jesus is the head of one church
 - 1. Jesus is the head of the church, which is His body (Eph. 1:20-23)
 - 2. There is only one body (Eph. 4:4)
 - 3. A body with many heads is a monstrosity as is a head with many bodies
- C. Jesus prayed that His followers would be one (John 17:20, 21)
 - 1. They are to be one as He and His Father are one
 - 2. There is no denominational or doctrinal difference between the Father and Son (John 10:30; 1 John 5:7)
 - 3. Religious division is condemned (1 Corinthians 1:10)
 - 4. Therefore Christ established only one church
 - 5. Every church not built in accordance with the word of God shall be rooted up (Matthew 15:9-13)

II. The organization of the church

- A. Jesus Christ is the Head of the church
 - 1. Ephesians 1:22, 23 and Colossians 1:18 make this fact clear
 - 2. Anyone else who claims to be the head of the church is guilty of seeking to take the Lord's place
- B. Elders are to be ordained in every church (Acts 14:23)
 - 1. Elders are given authority to oversee the church (Acts 20:17, 28)
 - a. In this context they are called "elders," "overseers," and "shepherds"
 - b. The Latin word for "shepherds" is "pastors"

- 2. Titus refers them as "elders" and "bishops" (Titus 1:5-7)
- 3. Both Titus and Paul give qualifications for elders (Titus 1:5-11; 1 Tim. 3:1-7)
- 4. Elders are given authority over the local congregation only (1 Pet. 5:1-5)
- 5. There must be a plurality of elders in each congregation (Phil. 1:1)
- C. Deacons are to be appointed under the authority of the elders (1 Tim. 3:8-12)
- D. Evangelists have authority to preach the Gospel but not to oversee the church (Eph. 4:11)

III. The worship of the church

- A. God demands that we worship Him in truth (John 4:23, 24)
 - 1. The Word of God is the truth (John 17:17)
 - 2. To worship God according to the doctrines of men is to worship in vain (Matthew 15:9)
- B. Jesus commanded his disciples to partake of the Lord's Supper (Luke 22:19, 20)
 - 1. The cup is the communion of the blood of Christ, and the bread of His body (1 Corinthians 10:16)
 - 2. The Lord's Supper was partaken of by the early Christians every Sunday (Acts 20:7)
- C. Christians are commanded to give as they have been prospered (1 Cor. 16:1, 2)
 - 1. We are to give every first day of the week
 - 2. We are to give as we have been prospered.
- D. Christians are commanded to sing (Ephesians 5:19)
 - 1. This passage specifies the human heart as the instrument to be used in Christian worship
 - 2. God wants to be worshipped with the instrument he created
- E. Christians heard the Bible taught when assembled for worship (Acts 20:7)
- F. Christians prayed together when assembled for worship (Acts 2:42)
